


## SourceAmerica.

### **ABILITYONE PROGRAM PROCUREMENT STEPS**

- 1. Conduct market research; consider past performance relevance to determine opportunity selection
- 2. Review draft solicitation & discuss requirement / Contracting Agency; obtain Contracting Officer's desire to leverage the AbilityOne program
- 3. Negotiate price, other terms & conditions with Nonprofit Agency (NPA) & Central Nonprofit Agency (CNA)
- 4. CNA sends procurement package, including fair market price recommendation to the AbilityOne Commission
- 5. AbilityOne Commission analysis & deliberation
- Determines suitability & fair market price
- Initial publication in Federal Register, package review, & Commission final decision
- 6. AbilityOne Commission publishes procurement addition
- Notice issued to Contracting Officer, NPA & CNA
- Contract award authorized after effective date
